Thank you for bringing dogs that are good with large crowds, face paint, strollers, etc.
- It was recommended to have a pre-Expo meeting for volunteers next year. Firm plans will start farther out and there will be reminders of what the dogs will be exposed to (why dogs are requested, not young puppies), PetExpo rules, etc.

• **Old Business:**

- CADF flyers are still being reviewed. CADF will distribute the posters to vet clinics, pet stores, etc.

New Business:

- Toby created a CADF Pamphlet. This is a great document for the breeders as well as CADF to hand out at events. Merla Thomson volunteered to review.
- An Education Committee was created. Toby Hatley will chair the committee with members Merla Thomson and Linda Berrar. Some suggested seminars are puppy contracts, kennel succession, dental hygiene, alternate medicine (laser, acupuncture, chiropractor) etc.
- CADF voted in favor of a Bronze Sponsorship AKC Summer Dog Show. This level of sponsorship includes a 10 x 10 tent and an AKC provided banner in the breed ring at the reduced rate of \$300. Donna LaChance moved to accept, Toby Hatley seconded (AIF).
